

Parents and or guardians

To prevent the spread of infection

1. Thoroughly manage your health, such as observing your child's and family's health and measuring their body temperature, every morning and evening.

If the child is found to be in poor physical condition after coming to kindergarten, we will rest the child in a separate room. Please come to pick up your child promptly. Please cooperate. The same applies to extended childcare.

2 "Basic infections" such as wearing a mask, after returning home, before meals, etc., diligent hand washing / gargle, face washing, ventilation, securing physical distance, avoiding "three Cs" (Crowded spaces / Close-contact settings / Confined and enclosed spaces)", etc. Please be thorough in "prevention".

3 When the child has symptoms (fever, cough, headache, malaise (dullness), taste / smell discomfort, etc.) that the child feels even a little sick, or the same sickness is seen in the family living together. Please do not hesitate to absent from kindergarten. In addition, make sure that your child is absent even when your family is instructed by a doctor to undergo a PCR test.

In such cases, the kindergarten will not treat waiting at home as absent.

4 If you feel uneasy about going to the kindergarten, please do not hesitate to contact the kindergarten.

5 We will provide appropriate guidance to children so that they will not be discriminated against or bullied based on misunderstandings or prejudices against infected persons, close contacts, etc. and their families due to anxiety and fear of the covid-19 infection.✂

6 If an infected person is confirmed in the kindergarten, we will cooperate with the health center and promptly carry out a PCR test on the kindergarten children who have come into contact with the infected person.

7 Please refrain from participating in "lessons", etc. when your child is in poor physical condition.

✂Avoid the Three Cs

1. **C**rowded places with many people nearby.
2. **C**lose-contact settings Especially where people have close-range conversations.
3. **C**onfined and enclosed spaces with poor ventilation.

◎We will work to balance educational activities and infection prevention through the following efforts, at the Kyogoku Kindergarten.

If you have any concerns, please contact us.

○ Thorough basic infection control measures

- Masks (Depending on the physical condition of the child, such as heat stroke, the child may need to remove the mask.)
- Frequent hand washing and disinfection
- Ventilation and disinfection of rooms, air purifier, etc.
- Securing physical distance between children, etc.
- Partition with a transparent plate
- Silent lunch

○ Health observation in the morning

Be sure to carry out health observations such as temperature measurement at home, and make sure that children have normal heat and that they are not in poor physical condition before come to the kindergarten. Please bring the health observation slip and have it confirmed by the staff.

○ Temporary suspension of activities outside the kindergarten (educational activities will be carried out only inside the kindergarten).

○ Temporary suspension of "educational activities with high risk of infectious diseases" indicated in the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology's hygiene management manual

- Activities where children are crowded together, activities where children talk in a loud voice all at once at a short distance, etc.

○ As a general rule, we do not hold parent visit days, parent meetings, or home visits.
